His ministry was the most dynamic ever shared with mankind;

- Luke 8:36-37 Power over devils
- Matthew 8:23-27 Power over elements
- John 11:43-44 Power over death

His death was even dynamic;

- Forgave a thief while dying
- From 12:00 3:00 in the afternoon it was dark as midnight
- The grave couldn't hold Him, He arose.
- He led the OT saints to Heaven.

Everything He created was dynamic;

- The Sun
- The smallness of our universe (bacteria and the unseen)
- The greatness of our universe (Undiscovered systems and galaxies)
- The power in an atom

The church is dynamic.

- Prophets who during the meeting are receiving revelations from God for those who gather 1 Corinthians 14:29-30
- The gift of tongues and interpretation are in operation at each service to edify, exhort, and comfort the worshippers 1 Corinthians 14:27-28
- It's people are filled with spiritual ministries to share 1 Corinthians 14:26, 2 Peter 2:5
- The Holy Spirit is so powerful that people worship together daily and with genuineness and sincerity.
- People are filled with unspeakable joy and glory 1 Peter 1:8
- Healing of sick bodies are common place James 5:14-15
- Unbelievers are so moved by the Spirit that they fall on their faces and confess God in the midst - 1 Corinthians 2:1-5, Galatians 3:5, 1 Corinthians 14:24-26
- People who have not been filled with the Holy Spirit, receive by the laying on of hands Acts 8:14-17

- It is being created for a dynamic future 1 Corinthians 15:42-26, John 14:2-3, 1 Thess. 16-17
- We have been given a dynamic authority. Matthew 16:19
- It's revelation comes from God is a constant flow 1 Cor. 2:14, 1 Cor. 14:29-30, Matthew 16:17
- It minsters the dynamite power of God. Galatians 3:5
- It has it's anchor beyond the veil and cannot be shaken Hebrews 6:19, Hebrews 12:28
- It is filled with Spiritual gifts 1 Corinthians 12:7-11
- Its God is consuming fire and He makes his ministers a flame of fire. Hebrews 12:29, Hebrews 1:7
- It's dynamic because God is actively working in it. Mark 16:20
