Recap of Dynamic Church

- The not so basic information you need to know.
- The Church, that you are apart of, is to be a place of dynamic encounter. Never settle for man's form over God's power. The Church was never meant to be a place where God's people gathered to just talk about HIM, but a place to be together to spend time with HIM.

Recap of Dynamic Christian

- You are going to need a dynamic persistence. No forward motion goes untested. There is a resistance that you will face getting involved in the Kingdom of God.
- You must know; He knows you. He has called you. He is madly in love with you. He has a plan, specifically for you that is greater than all you can ask or imagine. To the level that you will go in will be the level that you are able to receive and abide in His purpose. GO ALL IN!
 - Many lean into explanation.
 - Many lean towards expression.
 - We all must run towards demonstration.

The Not So Basic Information;

One of the main principles of how God advances His kingdom throughout scripture is important to know. He uses what I am calling the "Dynamic Duo".

- The two offices that us Spirit Filled people believe God uses the lay the groundwork for the moving of His Spirit is the office of the Minstrel and the Prophet.
- Minstrel: A person who through their worship gift opens the door to the presence of God.

Ezekiel 28:13 (NKJV), Psalm 150 (Psalmist describes the point of worship), 2 Kings 3:11-15



Worship wasn't the focal point, it was the funnel that provided the anointing for the gifts to be in operation.

The point of the minstrel was not a concert, but rather an invitation for God's presence to be welcomed.

1 Samuel 16:14-23

Just because you have music, doesn't mean you have worship.

Just because you have a service, doesn't mean you have His anointing.

Many churches are merely God clubs who talk about Him but never meet with HIM.

Amos 5:21-23 (God Speaking)

What is true worship?

1. True Worship is an invitation to God to transform my Life

1 Samuel 10:1-6

The most important touch from God I get, is the next one.

2. True Worship is inviting God to meet with His people.

Psalm 34:3-5 (KJV)

IN corporate worship, God does the miraculous.

He meets with us, touches me, and draws them.
