Be a Kid with God

1: Kids are always growing & always learning

• But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 3:18

2: Kids are excited & expectant

- In the morning, Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait expectantly. Psalm 5:3
- Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord. Psalm 27:14 (Another version says "Wait and hope for and expect the Lord.")

3: Kids carry a sense of wonder & awe

- Lift up your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one and calls forth each of them by name. Because of his great power and mighty strength not one of them is missing. Isaiah 40:26
- And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. 31 So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Matthew 10:30-31

4: Kids are needy

- You do not have because you do not ask God. James 4:2
- One thing I ask of the Lord, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple. Psalm 27:4
